

Dear Ponderosa Springs Residents:

Our 2026 Green Waste Project is fast approaching!

We are thrilled so far with the response of residents who are participating! This project is vital to keeping your and your neighbors' properties safer during this year's especially dry fire season. The project is scheduled for June 1st through 15th, 2026. There is no cost to residents for the pick-ups/disposal.

Details are as follows:

1. You are responsible for raking your property. Robin Shearer (phone # below) can provide you with names of several local companies who can provide a quote to do the raking for you.
2. The green waste accepted is defined by Gila County as “anything on your property that grows back (branches, pine needles, clippings, grass, bushes, logs, etc. *but no tree stumps.*”
3. Place your pile(s) of acceptable green waste on your property line, nearest to the road, for the most convenient pick-up access.
4. When your piles are completed (or when you plan on having them completed), contact Robin Shearer to arrange for pick-up @ 602-799-6857 (text only).

- Date pile(s) will be ready
